- The audience consists of volunteers, attorneys, practitioners, business professionals and others interested in dispute resolution.
- Writing style should be accessible to a wide range of readers.

#### **Ideal Submission Will:**

- Offer well researched insights into dispute resolution
- Be well written and edited appropriately for a wide audience
- May include discussion of tips, techniques or underlying theory that a dispute resolution practitioner could easily use
- Include links to additional online resources
- Students and academics are strongly encouraged to submit

#### **Articles Will Not Be Accepted If:**

- The article is a direct solicitation for your services or business (We do allow a short "About the Author" paragraph where you can include what you do and contact information at the end of your article)
- The article is not well written, edited or exceed the maximum length of two pages (12 pt Times New Roman Font with default margins)
- The article is submitted in hard copy or in an electronic format other than Microsoft Word or .pdf.
- NYSDRA cannot reprint the article due to copyright restrictions. Author must be willing to grant NYSDRA permission for publication.

#### **Submission Must Include:**

- 1-2 page article suitable for publication in Microsoft Word or .pdf format (12 pt Times New Roman Font with default margins)
- Short "About the Author" biography (50 words or less)
- Headshot in electronic format
- Contact information including full name, email, phone, websites or blogs
- Articles are accepted on a rolling basis
